**Our meadow seed is harvested from the SSSI meadows surrounding Ty Mawr on the shores of Llangorse Lake.**

It is harvested before being dried, sieved and packaged.

The species found in the meadows are

*Achillea Millefolium* Yarrow, *Achillea Ptarmica* Sneezewort, *Agrostis Capillaris* Common Bent, *Alliaria Petiolata* Garlic Mustard, *Anagallis Arvensis* Scarlet Pimpernel, *Bellis Perennis* Daisy, *Calystegia Bindweed*, *Campanula Rotundifolia* Harebell, *Capsella Bursa-Pastoris* Shepherd's-Purse, *Cardamine Pratensis* Cuckooflower, *Centaurea Nigra* Common Knapweed, *Circaea Lutetiana* Enchanter's-Nightshade, *Cirsium Arvense* Creeping Thistle, *Crepis Capillaris* Smooth Hawk's-Beard, *Cynosurus Cristatus* Crested Dog's-Tail, *Dactylorhiza Fuchsii* Common Spotted-Orchid, *Dactylorhiza Incarnata* Early Marsh-Orchid, *Dactylorhiza Marsh-Orchid*, *Digitalis Purpurea* Foxglove, *Epilobium Parviflorum* Willowherb, *Festuca Ovina* Sheep's-Fescue, *Festuca Pratensis* Meadow Fescue, *Festuca Rubra* Agg. ## Sowing

- Sowing is recommended in the autumn or spring by scattering on the required area either hand-thrown or with a seed spreader.
- If conditions are particularly dry, the seed will benefit from watering once scattered.

## Coverage

We suggest a coverage rate of

- 4g/m<sup>2</sup>
- 16kg/acre
- This can be upped to 5g/m<sup>2</sup> if only a small area is being done.
- A standard 1kg pack will do 200 m<sup>2</sup>.
